#### HEALTH AWARENESS MINISTRY



June is Men's Health Month, a national observance to raise awareness about health care for men and encourage lifestyles that include healthy eating and physical activity. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, men in the United States, on average, die five years earlier than women and die at higher rates from the three leading causes of death: heart disease, cancer, and unintentional injuries. Black men have higher death rates than women for all leading causes of death. Black men live 7.1 years less than other racial groups. Black men have the lowest health status and lowest life expectancy of any demographic. The three leading causes of death for Black men are heart disease, cancer, and stroke. It is estimated that 40% of Black men die prematurely from stroke.

Men are encouraged to take care of their health and mental wellness. Did you know:

- Heart disease is the number one killer of men. Make healthier lifestyle choices and make half your plate fruits and vegetables.
- 30 minutes of exercise is good for the heart and mind (40% of Black men 20 years of age and older have high blood pressure).
- Go to the doctor. Preventive maintenance-regular checkups can catch small problems before they become big problem (38% of Black men 20 years of age and older are obese).
- Smoking causes cancer, heart disease, and stroke (23% of Black men 18 years of age and over smoke cigarettes).
- Mental health is important. Every year, more than 40 million Americans struggle with mental illness. Black men are as likely as anyone to have mental illness, but they are less likely to get help. Depression and other mental illness can be deadly if left untreated. Suicide is the third leading cause of death among African Americans 15 to 24 years of age. Untreated mental illness can also make African American men more vulnerable to substance abuse, homelessness, incarceration, and homicide. Trauma has been identified as a major public health and medical issue, and Black males ages 18 and older are at a noticeably high risk for trauma exposure. It is suggested that 56–74% of Black males exposed to traumatic events have an unmet need for mental health services.

Talk to your health care provider about any issues with your health and wellness and mental well-being. Help is available.

#### Maturing Christians That Keep Growing

What does a mature Christian look like? Spiritual maturity usually focuses on how much members know about the Christian faith. If you know the Bible inside out, you're a mature Christian. That pretty much sums it up, right? **Well, there are two challenges with that.** 

- First, Jesus said that's the wrong definition. He set *love* as the mark of an authentic follower, not knowledge. The most knowledgeable religious people of Jesus' day nailed him to a cross.
- Second, the Apostle Paul pointed out that knowledge puffs up, but love builds up.

The problem with many Christians these days is that we pretend to know everything, but we love no one, with the possible exception of those who believe exactly what we do and act exactly like we do. That's about as far away from the enemy-love Jesus taught as it gets. What might happen to the church if *love* became the standard of our maturity?

#### MEN'S MINISTRY




The Men's Ministry has a weekly call via WebEx taking place at 7 pm Tuesdays. We invite all men to join the call.


